Position: SAVE Home Meal Prep
Supervisor: SAVE Home Manager
Time: 1-3 hours during either lunch (11-2pm) or dinnertime (4-7pm) hours
Commitment: As many or as few times as you'd like. We also offer weekly or monthly rotations if you'd like to be on an ongoing schedule.
Place: SAVE Home, the SAVE, Inc. 24-hour facility located in Midtown Kansas City.
Training: None required

Specific Duties:

- Prepare a nice meal to feed 8 people in the SAVE Home kitchen, or bring an already-prepared meal (or purchased meal) to share during the lunch or dinnertime hours. (please provide own ingredients if making in the SAVE Home kitchen)
- Stay and visit with the residents while they enjoy their feast!
- Baked goods or any other desserts are also welcome, either as an after-meal accompaniment, or a drop-in-anytime treat!

Requirements/Qualifications:

- Must maintain confidentiality of all SAVE, Inc. resident information and be able to visit comfortably and work fairly with individuals who have disabilities
- Possess an upbeat and pleasant personality with a passion to serve others
- A love of all things FOOD!
- Absolutely NO previous culinary experience required!
